INU SUMMER PROGRAM 2022 HIROSHIMA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

We are currently accepting applications for the annual INU Summer Program at the Hiroshima University, Japan. This year's program theme is:

“The Age of Artificial Intelligence: Opportunities and concerns”

The 2022 INU Summer Program, in its tenth annual iteration, is held each year at Hiroshima University. Students and teaching academic experts from INU universities in Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, North and South America, participate in the course. The course itself involves an intensive series of lectures, workshops, and seminars directed by professors from INU member universities. The program is open to both bachelor and master students from all three faculties of the Viadrina. Master students will need to hand in a 4000-word essay about one of three suggested topics.

Theme for 2022

The seminar aims to provide an opportunity to explore and reflect on the debates concerning increasing growth of Artificial Intelligence technology. The seminar will critically consider how Artificial Intelligence is increasingly impacting our day-to-day life looking at the opportunities it can provide as well as at the dangers it poses.

Participants will receive the Viadrina INU scholarship of approximately ~600€ and are eligible to the Japanese JASSO scholarship of further 80.000 Yen (~588 €)
