

**“Competing Digital Geopolitics: China and the EU”**  
**21 February 2019, 9.30 a.m.–6.00 p.m., at SWP-Berlin**

Together with the Chair for European and International Politics at the Viadrina European University and the Deloitte Center for the Long View, SWP is collaborating on a scientific project to develop strategies for Europe-China cooperation in the area of digital geopolitics.

The tested scenario methodology of Deloitte CLV is combined with innovative A.I. technology and expert knowledge to develop alternative scenarios for the future. Building on a diverse analysis of driving forces, we will develop four plausible scenarios for the future of digital geopolitical conflicts.

The workshop will focus on the following questions:

- What could conflicts in digital geopolitics look like in 2035?
- What role could the EU, China, and other, non-governmental, actors play in solving them?
- What areas and/or sectors of collaboration are of specific interest for EU and Chinese actors in the fields of digital geopolitics?
