Tasks will include:

- completing either a doctoral thesis or, for postdoctoral candidates, Habilitation thesis or equivalent scientific publications as part of their academic career trajectory in the context of the general profile of the professorship
- Contributing to the excellency and visibility of the research and teaching profile of the professorial team
- Teaching two classes per semester with a total of four hours per week in the context of different BA and MA courses offered by the Faculty of Cultural Sciences
- Cooperation with the research center B/Orders in Motion
- Contributing to and supporting international networking in research and teaching

Your profile should include:

- Having finished an excellent MA thesis or PhD thesis in the field of anthropological or sociological research on racism and intersectionality
- manifest experience in research and/or teaching on racism, intersectionality, theories of cultural difference
- an academic transcript showing successful participation in classes that focus on the themes mentioned above as well as on qualitative methods
- desirable is furthermore knowledge in one or several of the following areas: migration- and border-studies, gender studies and queer theory, post- and decolonial theory, and/or politics and societies of Middle- or Eastern Europe
- very good linguistic and writing skills in German, English and an additional language are not required but desirable. Non-German speakers are encouraged to apply.
