

## **Europe-Day Reloaded - Witebsk, Belarus and the European Union (KUL-12973)**

The European Union celebrates Europe Day every year on 9 May. The day is also celebrated in Frankfurt (Oder) and Słubice. The Frankfurt-Słubice Cooperation Centre is in charge of organising this event. A new concept for the celebration format is currently being developed. Within the framework of the seminar, students will be actively involved in this new concept. The aim is to develop formats by students for students. The seminar will discuss the extent to which the 30-year town twinning with Witebsk (Belarus) can serve as an anchor point for the development of student events. What does membership in the EU mean for practical cooperation on a transnational level and how can cross-border dialogue and cooperation arise in Europe beyond the EU?

Participants in the seminar learn how to develop and implement socio-cultural events based on a concrete example of the twin city Frankfurt (Oder)-Słubice. The seminar is conducted in close cooperation with the Frankfurt-Słubice Cooperation Centre, which gives students an insight into the work of the institution. Participation of international students is particularly desired.
