The Chair of European Studies at the European University Viadrina is seeking a **Student Employee (BA/MA)** to strengthen the team of the research and education project "ValEUs" (<https://valeus.eu/>).

- A grade point average (GPA) of "gut/good" or better, with strong academic skills demonstrated in your application documents
- Expertise in cultural, social, or historical studies with a focus on Europe is a strong advantage
- Strong editorial skills in English are required
- Proficiency in MS Office (incl. Excel) and the ability to quickly adapt to new software tools (e.g., CMS, databases)
- Keen interest in science communication
- A reliable, structured, and independent way of working
- Flexibility to provide timely (initial) responses to emails by the Viadrina team during the working week
