CALL WRITING FELLOW PROGRAMME

Writing Fellows are peer tutors at the Writing Center with targeted training for the integration of subject-specific and thematic knowledge with writing instruction. They support lecturers with their classes and provide students with individual feedback for their texts and writing process. Until **August 20, 2025**, lecturers can apply to the Writing Center to conduct a course in cooperation with the Writing Fellows Programme in the **winter semester 25/26**.

We recommend applying for the Writing Fellow Programme if ...

- ... you would like your students to independently expand their disciplinary knowledge by writing texts or if you would like them to work on selected topics such as writing with AI or for social media with a subject-specific outlook (*writing to learn*). At the same time, the students develop their academic research and writing skills individually (*learning to write*).
- ... academic or professional texts are part of the coursework or assessment (term papers, reports, essays, excerpts, reviews, journalistic texts, reports, etc.) in your class.
- ... you would like to design two shorter writing assignments with the Writing Fellow so that the Writing Fellow can provide the students with written feedback twice with enough time for the students to revise their assignment and so that the students benefit from follow-up writing consultations with the Writing Fellow.

What Writing Fellows do:

- Collaborate with the lecturer before the start of the class on the class's writing pedagogy approach and writing assignment structure according to the lecturer's requirements as well as record the class's individual writing design and the specifics of the collaboration between Writing Fellow and lecturer in a written agreement.
- Offer in-depth written and oral feedback to all students for their texts twice per semester and give optional mini workshops tailored to specific writing needs in the class.
- Consult with all students once in the second half of the semester on their individual writing process and their progress with their writing assignments, discussing topics

like writing strategies, line of argument, text genre requirements or revision strategies.
