Prof. Paul Zalewski lädt zum Gastvortrag im Rahmen des internationalen Moduls am Masterstudiengang Schutz Europäischer Kulturgüter ein:

Cultural heritage in the Netherlands: towards integrated approaches

As in other countries throughout Europe the Netherlands have an elaborate infrastructure for each of the traditional heritage sectors: museums, archives, monuments and sites, archaeology, etc. Before 1990 the term "cultural heritage" was not used in government documents. During the last twenty years we see a strong tendency to integrate the heritage sectors and to develop integral policies, using "cultural heritage" as umbrella term. On a local level new types of institutions are created expressing a similar approach. Thus, gradually a new infrastructure emerges, replacing the old ones. This involves new concepts of professionalism requiring new approaches to practice, theory and ethics.

The lecture will be held in English, but there will be an opportunity for questions and discussion in German.

As researcher he is interested in developing an integral and integrated approach to heritage.
